In the United States, youth are being organized by [U.S. Climate Strikes](#), with the goal of March 15, 2019 being a rallying point for youth engagement across America. Protests and actions are being organized across California, United States, and countries around the world.

Students are being encouraged to organize acts of solidarity on their school campus. This movement is being paired with the one-year anniversary (March 14th) of the #Enough movement (protesting Congress' inaction on gun violence). In 2019, #Enough has grown into the [#Enough - Youth Week of Action](#), taking place between March 11 - 15th and concluding with standing in solidarity with the [Youth Climate Strikes](#) on Friday, March 15th.
